Full Launch (14th March 2019) - this was a fantastic success. Thank you so much to all the citizens, community groups, providers and statutory services that spread the word through Twitter, Facebook, word of mouth and their own publicity channels. Many also provided Live Well York drop-in sessions both on the day and either side of 14th March. Local media also covered the launch including York Press, That's TV York, BBC Radio York, Minster FM and Big Issue.

We had lots of feedback comments that helped to build the doodle art image on launch day with live postings as it developed in York Explore library.



We also gathered everyone's comments to make a word cloud which developed on the day as more feedback came in.



Live Well York website usage stats for launch day were very encouraging:



Mobile Devices – previously we gave advice regarding how to add the Live Well York logo as a short-cut on the home screen of your desktop PC or laptop. We appreciate many people use mobile devices, particularly when having conversations with people looking for solutions. Here are instructions to create a short-cut on your mobile device:

Android devices

- Type <u>www.livewellyork.co.uk</u> into your mobile device browser (e.g. Chrome, Samsung internet etc.)
- Once loaded tap on the 3 dots in top-right of the screen
- Tap "add to home screen"
- Amend the short-cut name to "Live Well York"
- Tap "add"

Apple iOS devices

- Type <u>www.livewellyork.co.uk</u> into Safari browser
- Once loaded tap the bottom central Action button (square with upward pointing arrow)
- Tap "add to home screen"
- Amend the short-cut name to "Live Well York"
- Tap "add"
