Mobile Devices

Previously we gave advice regarding how to add the Live Well York logo as a short-cut on the home screen of your desktop PC or laptop. We appreciate many people use mobile devices, particularly when having conversations with people looking for solutions. Here have provided instructions to create a short-cut on your mobile device:

<u>Android devices</u>	<u>Apple iOS devices</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Type www.livewellyork.co.uk into your mobile device browser (e.g. Chrome, Samsung internet etc.)• Once loaded tap on the 3 dots in top-right of the screen• Tap “add to home screen”• Amend the short-cut name to “Live Well York”• Tap “add”	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Type www.livewellyork.co.uk into Safari browser• Once loaded tap the bottom central Action button (square with upward pointing arrow)• Tap “add to home screen”• Amend the short-cut name to “Live Well York”• Tap “add”
